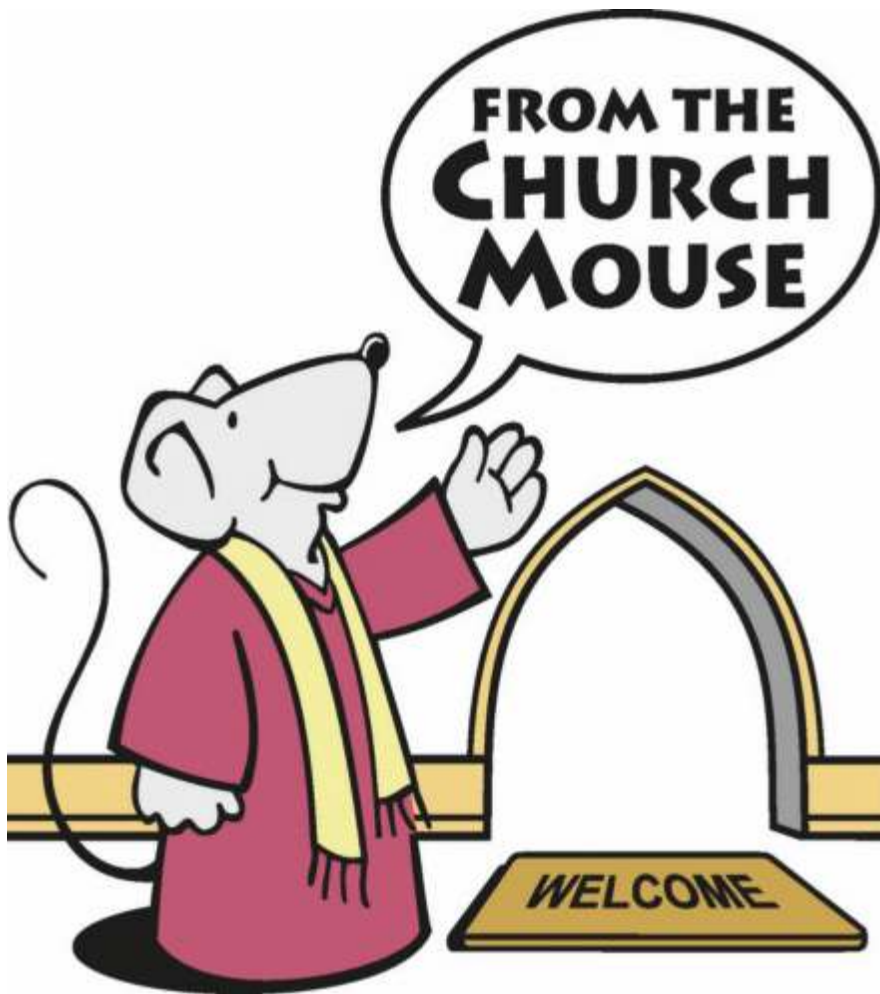

Dear Friends

For many years St Nicholas Church has been involved in a national fundraising day called Ride and Stride, which always takes place on the second Saturday in September. It's organised by all the Historic Churches Trusts around the country and the idea is that people can get sponsored to walk or cycle to different churches. Half the sponsor money raised in our local area goes to Worcestershire and Dudley Historic Churches Trust and the other half to the local church where the keen walker or cyclist has come from.

St Nicholas has a wonderful reputation for serving amazing refreshments to any visiting walkers and cyclists on Ride and Stride Saturday, which this year will be **9th September**. This year we have decided to have an **Open Day** at St Nicholas to coincide with Ride and Stride, to which everyone is warmly welcome. It's not always easy to have our church open during the week so the PCC thought this was a good way to open the doors to the whole village.

The Church will be open from 10am to 6pm for everyone to come and have look around. So if you haven't seen our incredible wall paintings come and have a look! There will also be displays for you to look at including ones from Pinvin Pre-School and Pinvin Federation of Schools; one detailing all the work the PCC has done on the fabric of the church over the past few years and one telling the stories of the men who died during the World Wars who came from the village, who are remembered on our war memorial.

As you enjoy the displays and look around the church there will also be light refreshments available, including a strawberry tea which will be served at 2pm.

Please do come and share in our Open Day and see what a beautiful church we have in the village, where community groups can share what they do and where we can enjoy the hospitality which St Nicholas is famous for.

Notes from Pinvin Parish Council



- ***New homes Bonus - Speed Initiatives:***

The Parish Council has submitted its proposals for speed initiatives to the District Council, and these will be considered by the Localism Panel on 4th September. Should the Parish Council be

successful in its application to utilise its New Homes Bonus allocation, measures to tackle speeding in the village will be initiated and implemented in the Autumn.

- ***Youth Bus:*** A second visit to the village took place on 28th July. It is anticipated that further visits will take place over the coming months at Pinvin Middle School, and children in the village aged 8-17 years old are encouraged to drop in and say hello. Further dates will be advertised on the Parish website and notice board once received.

- ***'Your life your choice'*** -The Worcestershire County Council website Your Life Your Choice has recently been reviewed as a result of an evaluation. It is now a lot easier to upload information about one off events and to add events that run on a regular basis. The County Council is keen to have a wide range of information about activities happening across Wychavon - the Your Life Your Choice website will be promoted widely as the place to go for information about health and wellbeing events and activities as a valuable way to share what's happening locally. If you are able to load information onto the website or ask the providers of local activities to do this, this would be a valuable resource for communities and encourage more people to become involved. Nature notes

Although the hottest days of June are comfortably behind us, the sun is still quite powerful when it appears from behind the cloud layer caused by the remains of tropical storm Gert. The first of the summer visitors to turn southwards, the swifts, have already taken their leave of us. There were fewer in evidence wheeling through our summer sky than of recent years. This may be influenced by the lack of suitable nest sites caused by modern building methods. New builds can have swift bricks inserted at little cost.

The seed feeders remain very popular with the smaller birds considering the season, and the few squirrels in the village are busy hiding hazel nuts and even harvesting walnuts. Hedgehogs set out on their regular patrol to look for bonus food bowls as well as their usual invertebrate delicacies. A water supply is most welcome in dry conditions.

This summer has been sadly short of butterflies, both different species and numbers. We can be over tidy with our weeds on which many butterfly and moth caterpillars feed.

What's Cooking? MARROW AND APPLE CHUTNEY

2lb / 1Kg Marrow-peeled and seeded

2lb / 1Kg cooking apples-peeled and cored

2oz. / 50g crystallised ginger-finely chopped

8oz / 250g onions-peeled and finely chopped

12oz / 375g brown sugar

15 fl oz / 470ml white wine vinegar

1 in. / 2.5cm piece root ginger

½oz./15g whole cloves

1 dried chilli pepper

1. Chop marrow & apple into 1"/.2.5cm cubes; place in a large pan
2. Add crystallised ginger, onions, sugar & vinegar. Add root ginger, chilli & cloves in a muslin bag.
3. Bring to the boil stirring all the time, then simmer for 1½ to 2 hours or until chutney is thick
4. Remove muslin bag, cool slightly and pot into warmed clean dry jars.

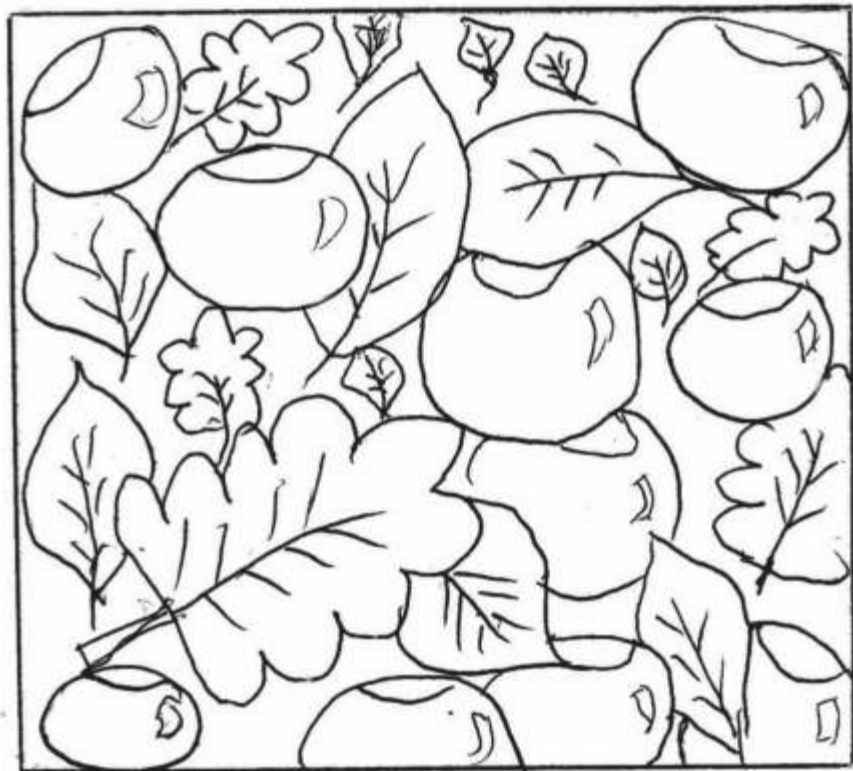
